INCENTIVES

- **Super Recruiter Pins:** Members who recruit two (2), or more, new NARFE members will receive a unique California Federation Super Recruiter pin in recognition of their recruiting efforts.
- Recruitment Cash Awards: Any member who recruits a new member(s) will receive a \$10 recruitment incentive check from the Federation for each new member recruited. All members who recruit ten (10), or more, new NARFE members during the two-year period between CSF conventions will receive a check for \$75. The two-year period will be from April 1st of a convention year to March 30 of next CSF convention cycle.

• **Dues Withholding Rebates:** Any annuitant who signs up for dues withholding will receive a check for \$15.00. Any spouse who signs up for dues withholding will receive a check for \$5.00.

• **Dues Withholding Raffle:** All CSF Chapter Members, who are on Dues Withholding, will have their names placed in an annual drawing to have one name drawn and receive \$250.00 cash prize.

RECRUITMENT

NARFE Elevator Speech

- An elevator speech is simply a quick overview. In this case, it's the best way to present NARFE and the value of membership within a limited amount of time. We seldom have the luxury of a relaxed, extended discussion with a potential NARFE member—it's usually a hurried pitch to busy attendees at a meeting, a chance encounter with a newly discovered fellow Fed, or a phone conversation with a friend of a friend. A clear, focused elevator speech helps you use the time efficiently and effectively.
- •The best speech should be tailored to your audience, and will focus on answering four key questions: What is NARFE?
- • What does NARFE do?
- • What benefits do I receive as a NARFE member?
- • What is the value of NARFE membership?
- •Use these points to communicate the value of NARFE membership to prospective members What is NARFE? NARFE is the National Active and Retired Federal Employees Association. It is the only organization *solely* dedicated to protecting and preserving the pay and benefits of all federal workers and retirees.
- NARFE has two primary roles:
- Your Legislative Voice. In-house, influential lobbyists advocate on Capitol Hill on behalf of the federal community.
- Your Information Resource. NARFE provides clear information and trusted guidance on complex federal benefits issues. Use your Service Officer and it's ok to say: "I don't know but I will check for you."
