CALIFORNIA STATE FEDERATION EXECUTIVE BOARD POLICY 11(A) SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT CHAPTER REVITALIZATION

The Special Assistant for Chapter Revitalization shall be appointed by the Federation President and serves as the Federation advisor for the wellness of Chapters. The Federation President, when informed that a Chapter is experiencing vitality problems, may assign the Special Assistant to assist that Chapter toward revitalization.

I. The Special Assistant:

- A. Will represent the Federation response to the appropriate District Vice President and/or Chapter who requested the assistance.
- B. Shall coordinate the activities, as necessary, with the Federation President, Federation Executive Vice President, appropriate District Vice President and/or Chapter president.
- C. May lead an On-Call Team of Federation Past Presidents and/or experienced NARFE members to assist the concerned Chapter.
- D. Will in coordination with the appropriate District Vice President submit to the President an after action report at the completion of each chapter revitalization assignment.
- E. Performs other duties as assigned.
- II. Chapter Revitalization procedures, depending on situations and circumstances, are complex and varied. The following references should be used as guidelines:
