I'm pleased to announce that once again the California State Federation of Chapters (CSFC) will offer incentives and rewards to chapter members for their efforts in recruiting and retaining NARFE members. It is only through the hard work and dedication of our members that NARFE will continue to grow and thrive. And so, it is only fitting that rewards be given to those who are successful in their endeavors to strengthen our Association and Federation through recruitment and retention.

The following incentives, rewards and rebates will be in place during the Fiscal Year April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011:

Super Recruiter Pins:

Members who recruit two (2) or more new NARFE members will receive a unique California Federation Super Recruiter pin, in recognition of their recruiting efforts. Pins will be awarded following each three-month period beginning April 1, 2010 and continuing through March 31, 2011.

Recruitment Cash Awards:

All members, excluding the four (4) Federation Officers, who recruit ten (10) or more new NARFE members during the period April 1, 2010 – March 31, 2011, will receive a check for **\$75** following the end of the Fiscal Year.

Dues Withholding Rebates:

Any annuitant who signs up for dues withholding will receive a check for **\$10.00**.

Any spouse who joins NARFE will receive a check for **\$5.00**.

Any spouse who signs up for dues withholding will receive a check for **\$5.00**.

Please Note: To claim a dues withholding rebate, send a copy of your dues withholding form (filled out) to CSFC Treasurer Werner Gumpert, 50 Picardy Court, Walnut Creek, CA 94597-3110.

Dues Withholding Chapter Incentive:

Any chapter that has twenty (20) members of their chapter sign up for dues withholding between April 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011, will receive a check for **\$30** following the end of the Fiscal Year.
