

California State Federation of Chapters (CSFC) Hall of Fame

I. Purpose

The CSFC Hall of Fame (HOF) is established to recognize federation members who have served the Federation in a manner well above that expected of them in the capacities of the positions they held.

II. Eligibility

Any current, former, living or deceased member of the CSFC.

III. Criteria for Candidacy

All candidates for selection to the HOF will have demonstrated their performance towards the furtherance of NARFE Federation (**not chapter**) objectives while a member of the CSFC, in a manner far exceeding that which is expected of them. **Chapters of the Federation are encouraged to develop and implement a Chapter HOF to recognize members who have far exceeded what is expected for them.**

IV. Application for Candidacy

A. The CSFC Secretary must receive candidate resumes not less than 30 days before the start of a CSFC Convention, as appropriate. The resumes should contain all the information required to show the **candidate** has demonstrated outstanding performance on behalf of NARFE **Federation** objectives, and the time periods involved. They may be transmitted via Email, FAX, or USPS.

B. The CSFC Secretary will log in the application, and forward it to the Federation President for review and processing as described below.

V. Judgment of Candidates Resumes

Candidate resumes will be judged by a committee of past federation presidents appointed by the Federation President. **No more than three each of living and deceased candidates, for a total of six candidates will be selected for induction to the CSFC HOF during any selection cycle. The Chair of the selection committee will forward the results of the candidate selection to the Federation President, who will personally arrange for the awards. Candidate selection information will remain confidential until the awards are presented.**

VI. Awards

Candidates selected for induction to the CSFC HOF will be recognized with an

appropriate award at Federation Conventions. **Their resumes will be posted on our Federation web site as soon as possible after our convention.**

VII. Program Publicity

This program and procedures shall be publicized to the greatest extent possible, especially on the CSFC web site, and CSFC newsletter, as applicable. The Federation Public Relations Committee Chair will oversee this program to assure it is functioning as prescribed.

A list of those previously inducted into the CSFC Hall of Fame will be shown at all CSFC conventions.

A copy of this procedure will be included in the Call to Convention package and also listed on our Federation web site.
